

## PROCEEDINGS OF GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Sub: Implementation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme- National Rural Livelihood Mission in the State of Karnataka through Karnataka State Rural Livelihood Promotion Society (KSRLPS)- Reg.

### Preamble:-

Government of Karnataka has been implementing many anti-poverty schemes in the rural areas. Swarnajayanthi Gram Swarozgar Yojana (SGSY) is one such scheme being implemented by the Department of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, since April 1999.

Based on a systematic review of SGSY, the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India has decided to restructure SGSY through the establishment of the National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM), vide letter dated 25-10-2010 read at (1) above.

Further, MoRD, Government of India has informed that each State is expected to transit to NRLM by constituting a State Rural Livelihood Mission (SRLM) to oversee the implementation of all NRLM related activities in the State and implement the scheme in a Mission mode vide letter dated 21-06-2011 read at (2) above.

Therefore, Government felt an urgent need to set up the Karnataka State Rural Livelihood Promotion Society (KSRLPS) to undertake the activities expected of the State Rural Livelihood Mission (SRLM) and act as the implementing agency for NRLM in the State and to establish State Mission Management Unit under KSRLPS. Government also felt it necessary to empower the Executive Committee of KSRLPS to enable to roll out the Mission in the State and take decisions regarding HR, Procurement and Administrative

matters including Finance. The funding of the Mission would be shared by the Central and State Government in the ratio of 75:25.

Accordingly, detailed proposals for setting up of a SRLM were prepared and examined in consultation with Planning and Finance Departments. It was proposed that this scheme would be implemented in the select 20 blocks of the five Districts in the first phase. The selection of Blocks was based on the Report of Dr. Nanjundappa Committee and Social Mobilisation in the District. Further, the matter was placed before the Cabinet and the Cabinet has accorded approval to the proposal, vide its decision dated 15-09-2011 read at (3) above. Hence this Order:

In light of the circumstances explained in the preamble, Government are pleased to accord approval;

- i) To constitute the Karnataka State Rural Livelihood Promotion Society (KSRLPS) as the implementing agency for National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) in the State of Karnataka under the Karnataka Societies Registration Act, 1960.
- ii) To establish a State Mission Management Unit under KSRLPS.
- iii) To empower the Executive Committee of KSRLPS to roll out the National Rural Livelihood Mission in the State and take decisions regarding HR, Procurement and Administrative matters including Finance.
- iv) To converge various programmes of Line departments such as Departments of Women & Child Development, Health, Education, Social Welfare, Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Horticulture, Labour, Employment and Training, Industries and Commerce and Co-operation etc. for achieving the objectives of NRLM in the State.
- v) In the first phase, to implement the NRLM scheme in the following 20 Blocks covering five Districts as per the guidelines / instructions of MoRD, New Delhi.
